

HOW TO ACCESS E-LEARNING PLATFORM AS A STUDENT AND ENROLL YOUR COURSES USING ANDROID PHONES (SMART PHONES)

THINGS TO NOTE BEFORE ACCESSING E-LEARNING PLATFORM

1. You **MUST** know your Student official Email or Application number or Registration/Matriculation number.
2. For new students (2019/2020 Session and onwards); You **MUST** have paid your acceptance fee, uploaded your documents online for E-Screening (Online Screening) and you must have been screened successfully.
3. You **MUST** have paid your school fees for the current session with the unique RRR number generated from your **Portal Dashboard** or sent to you on your **Screening Dashboard** or by **SMS** (*Incase you did not get an sms, send "allow" as sms to 2442 to disable Do-Not-Disturb on your phone line or Log into your screening dashboard by clicking on this link http://erp.fpno.edu.ng:8080/index.php?register/start_screening; then type in your application number and O'level verification RRR number to check your screening status*) after Successful First Screening - E-screening (Online Screening) for new students.
4. You **MUST** have logged into your Portal Dashboard to process the school fees RRR number to get the receipt.
5. To get your Student official Email, Log into your Portal Dashboard and click on profile to find it.

STEP 1

Open “**Google Chrome**” application on your phone. Ensure that you have data and it is on – ensure that you have access to the internet.

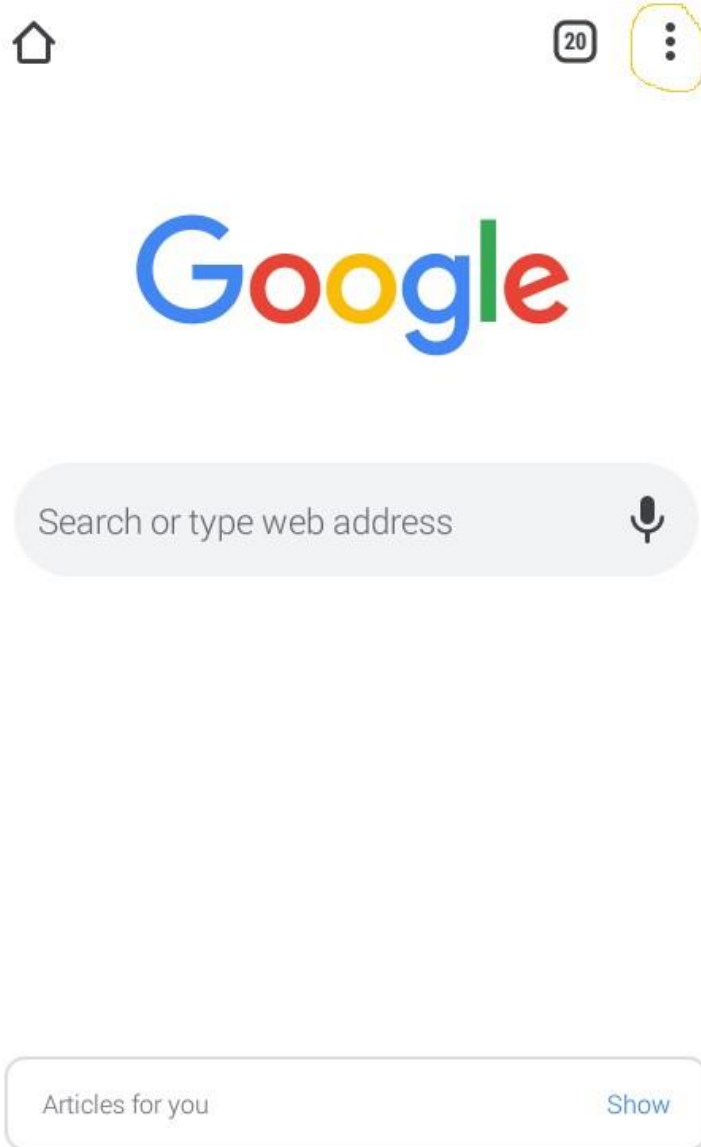

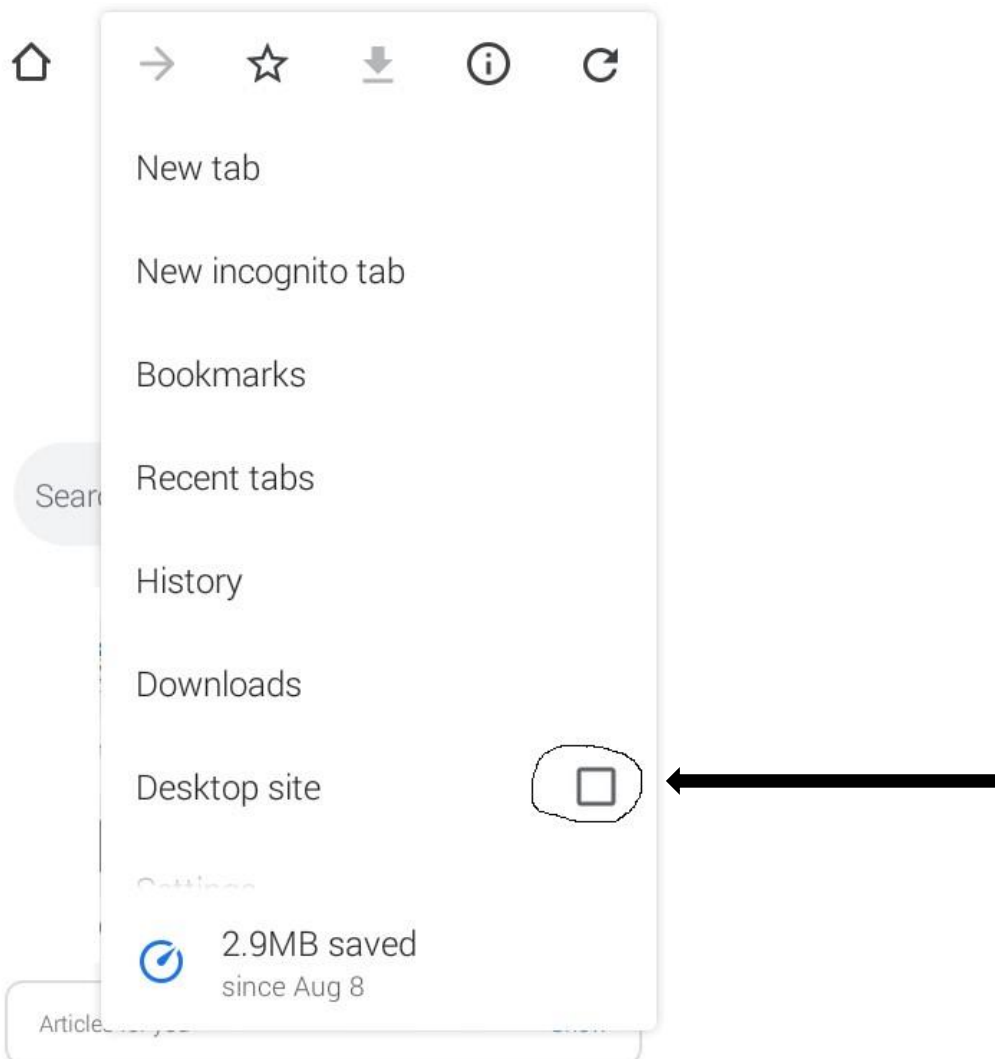

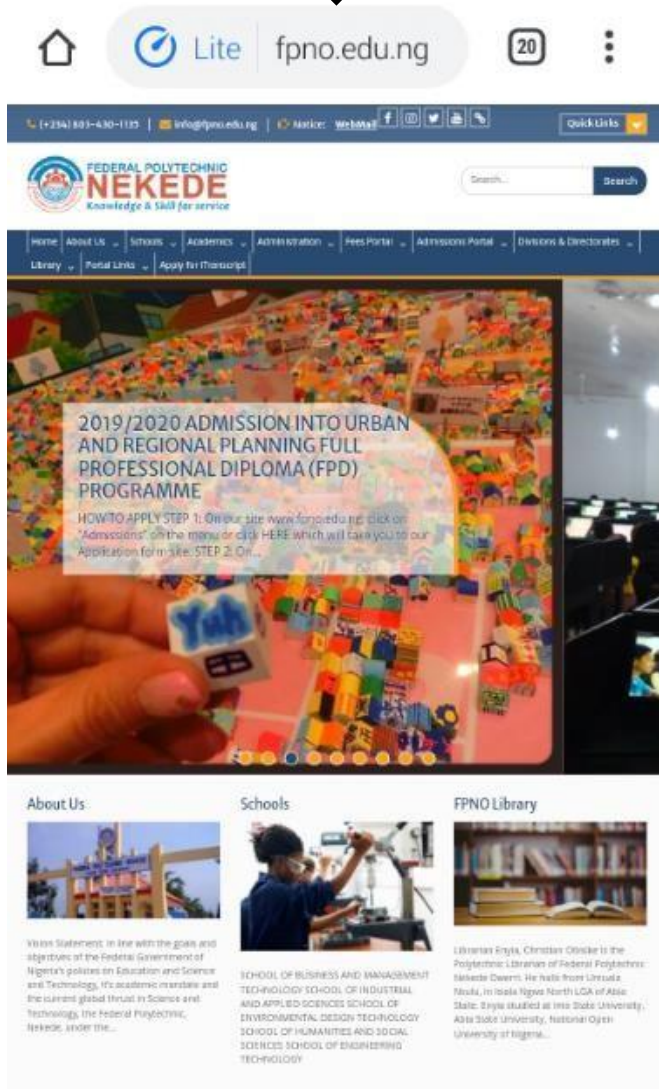
Turn on the desktop view of your “**Google Chrome**” browser. By clicking on the three dots on the circled part as shown below.



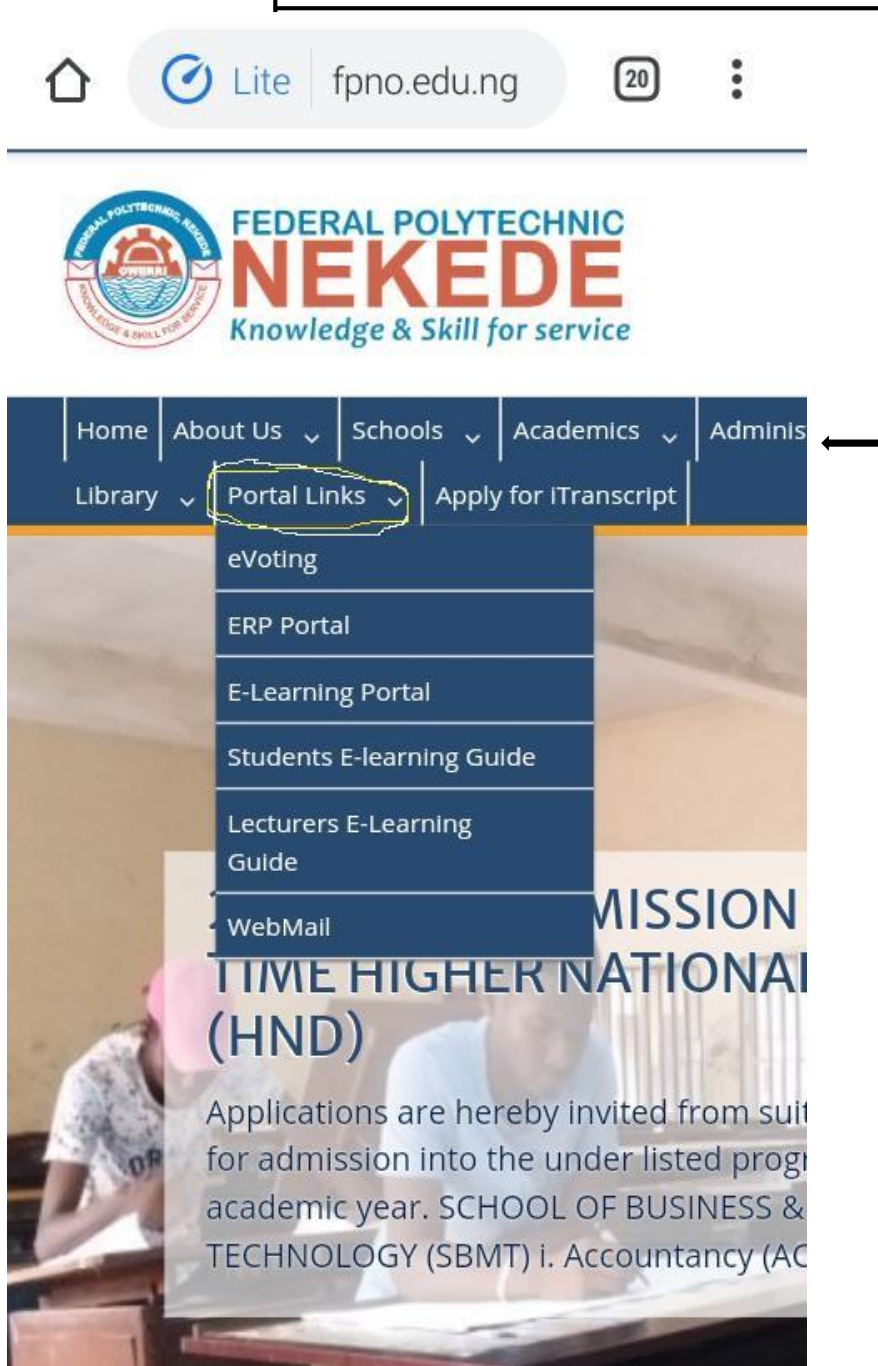
STEP 3: Click the square by “Desktop site”



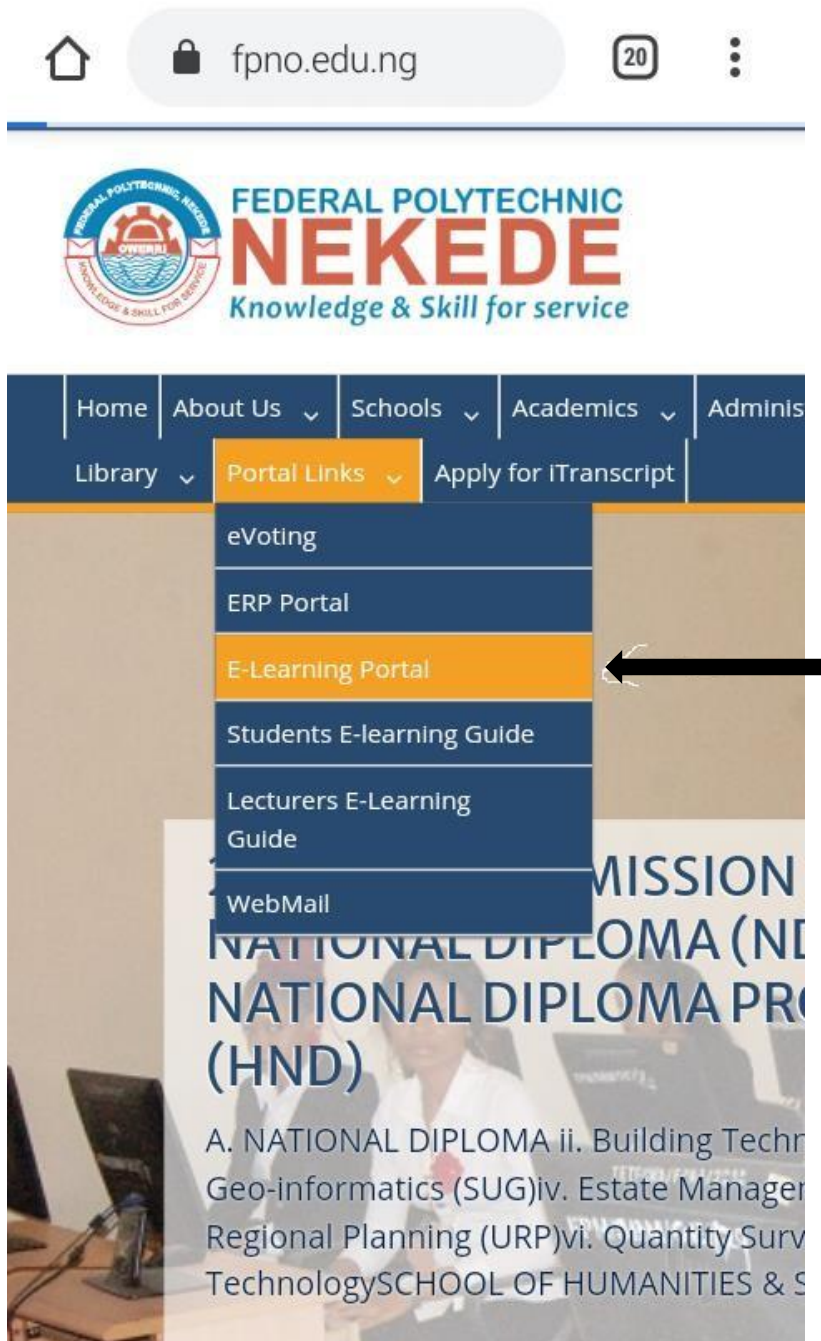
STEP 4: On the address bar, type www.fpno.edu.ng and press enter to load the school website homepage as shown below.



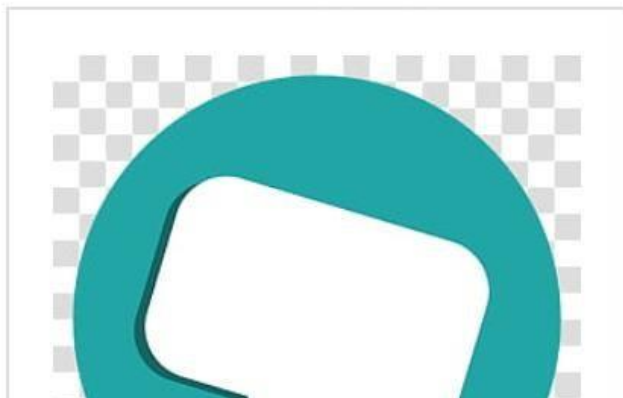
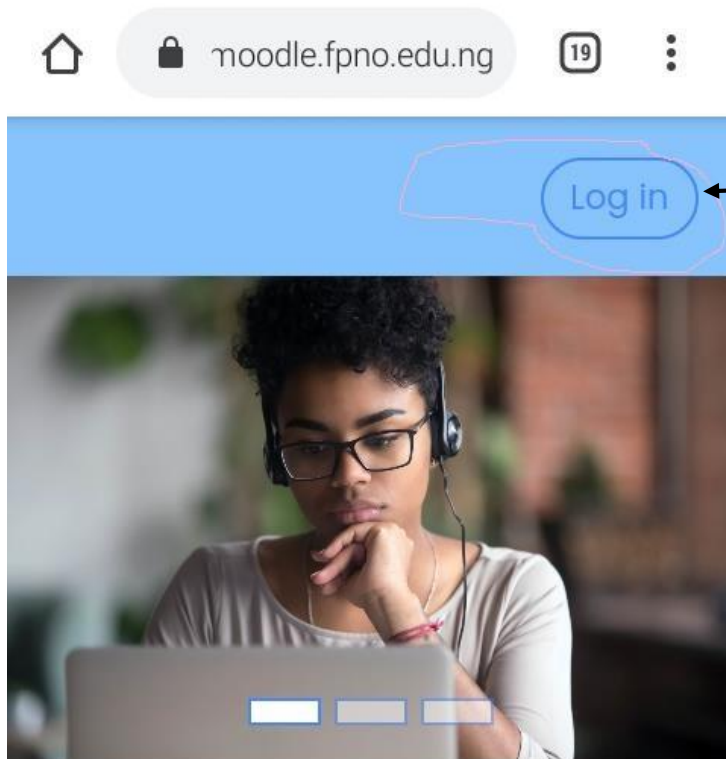
STEP 5: On the menu bar, locate **“Portal Links”** as shown below.



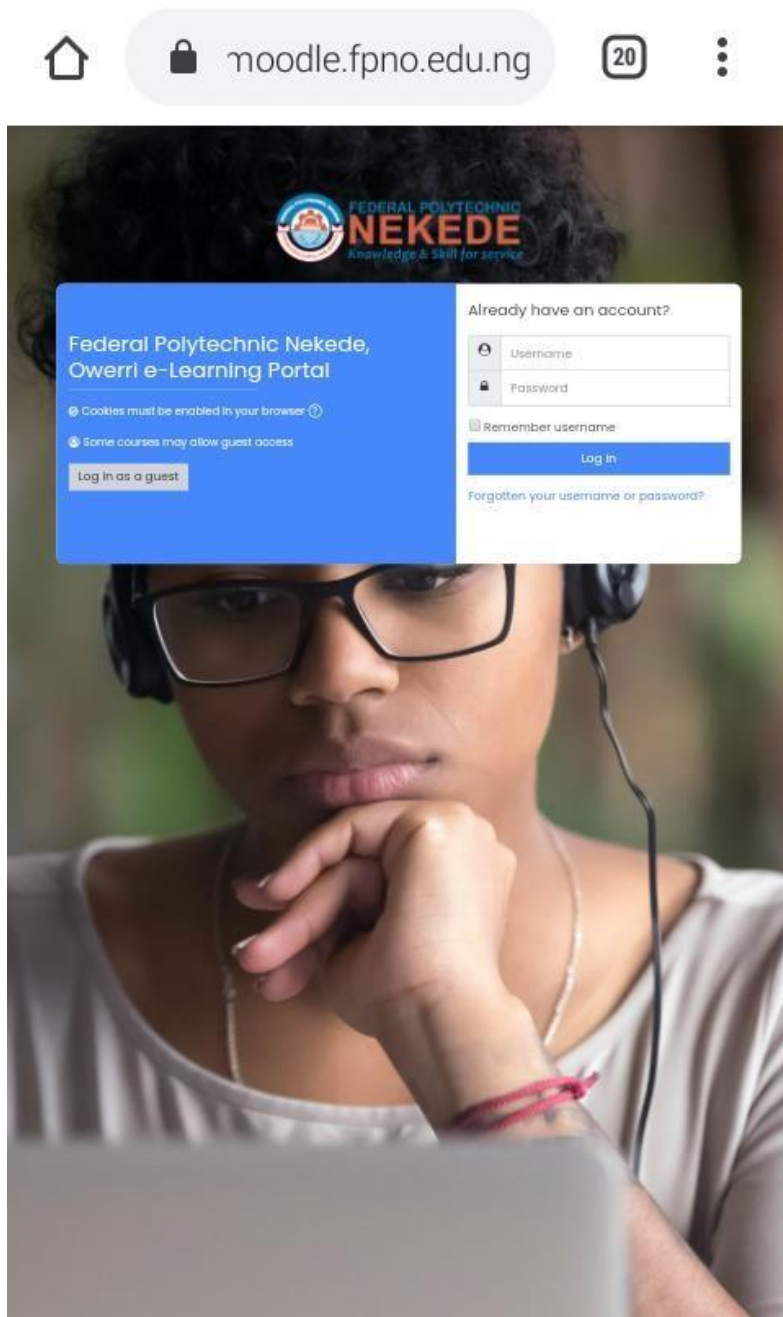
STEP 6: On the drop down menu from “**Portal Links**”, locate “**E-Learning Portal**” and click on it.



STEP 7: It will take you to the E-Learning platform as shown below, click on **Log in**



STEP 8: This will reveal where you will type in your **Username** which is the Student official Email/Application number/Reg. Number/Matriculation, followed by your **Password** as shown below.



STEP 9: Type in your Student official Email/Application number/Reg. Number/Matriculation number if you have.

NOTE: remove the slashes (.///..) found in those numbers – example:

FPN/HND/2024/0000000003456 will be typed as **FPNHND20240000000003456**

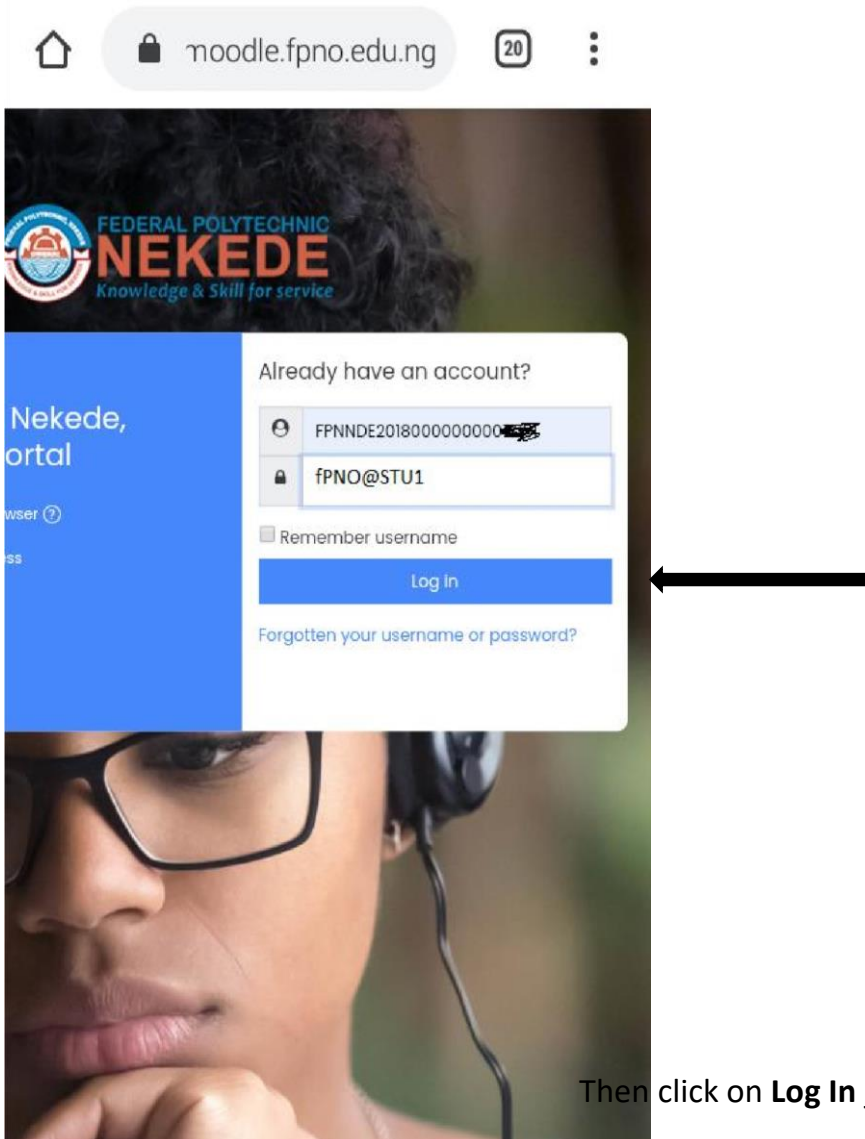

Default Password for all students is **fpno@STU1**

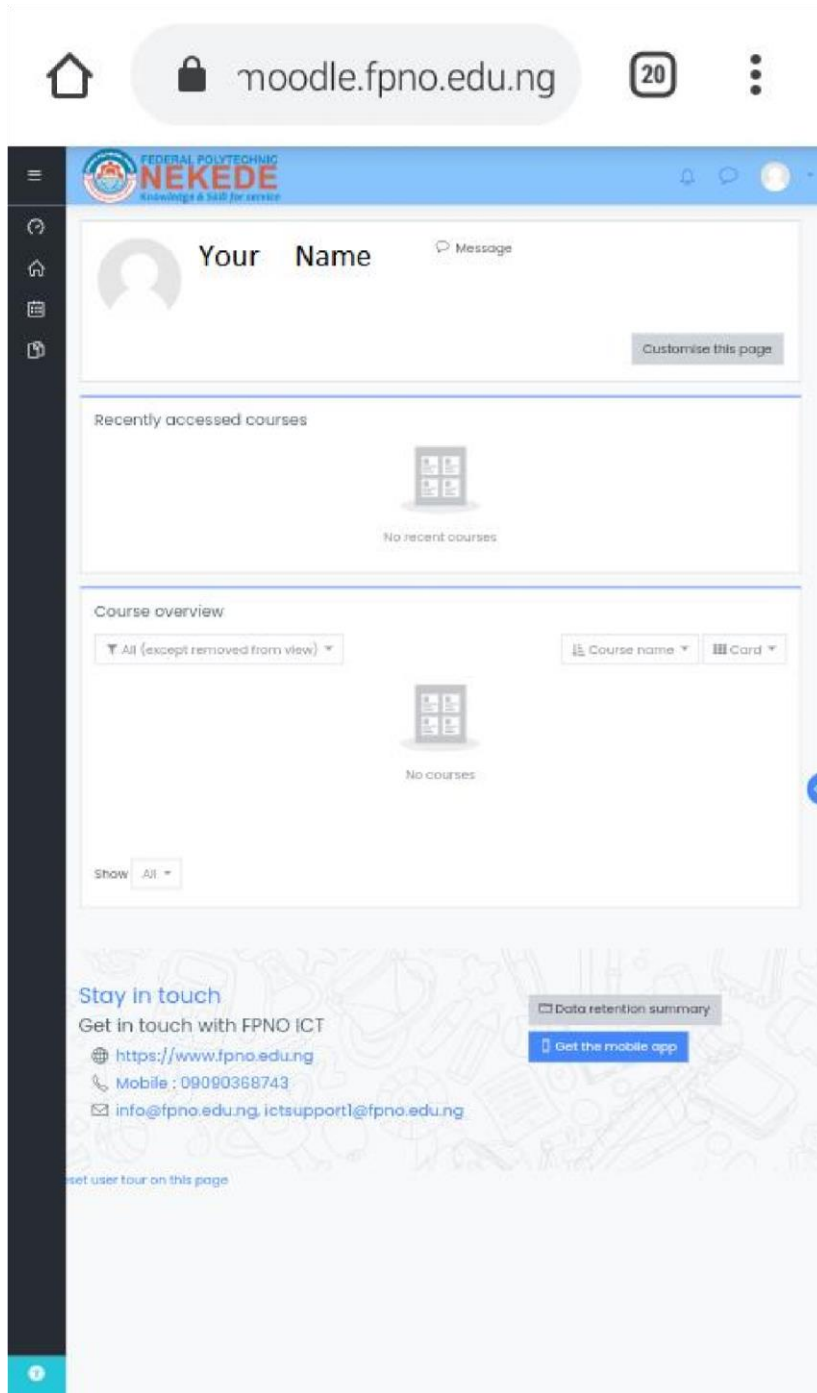
ALSO: The password is **CASE SENSITIVE**, just type it as it is.

Where your **Student official Email/Reg. Number/Matric Number** didn't work, please use your **Application number** without the slashes.



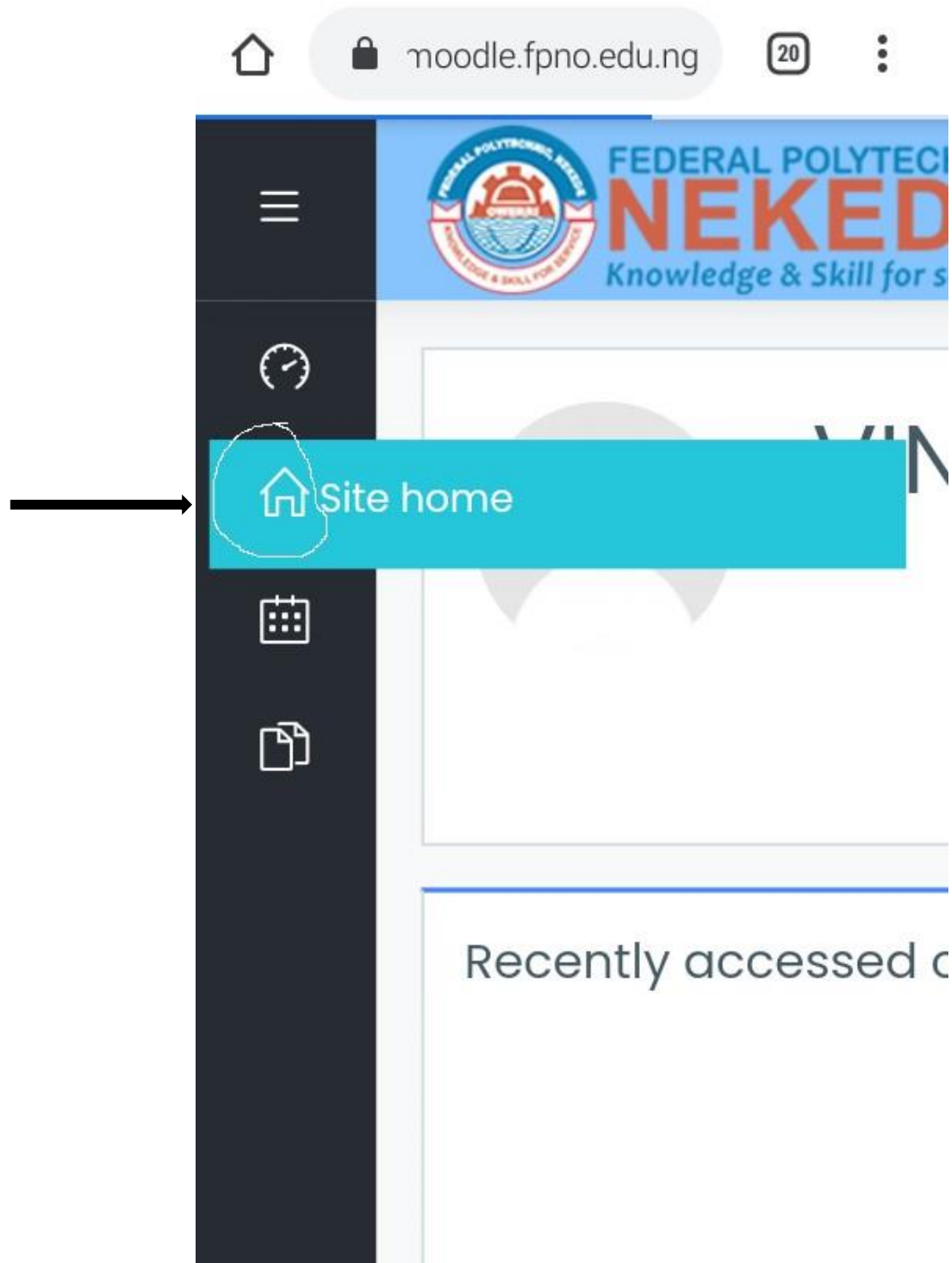
Then click on **Log In** just below the password.

HOW TO ENROLL YOUR COURSES AS A STUDENT

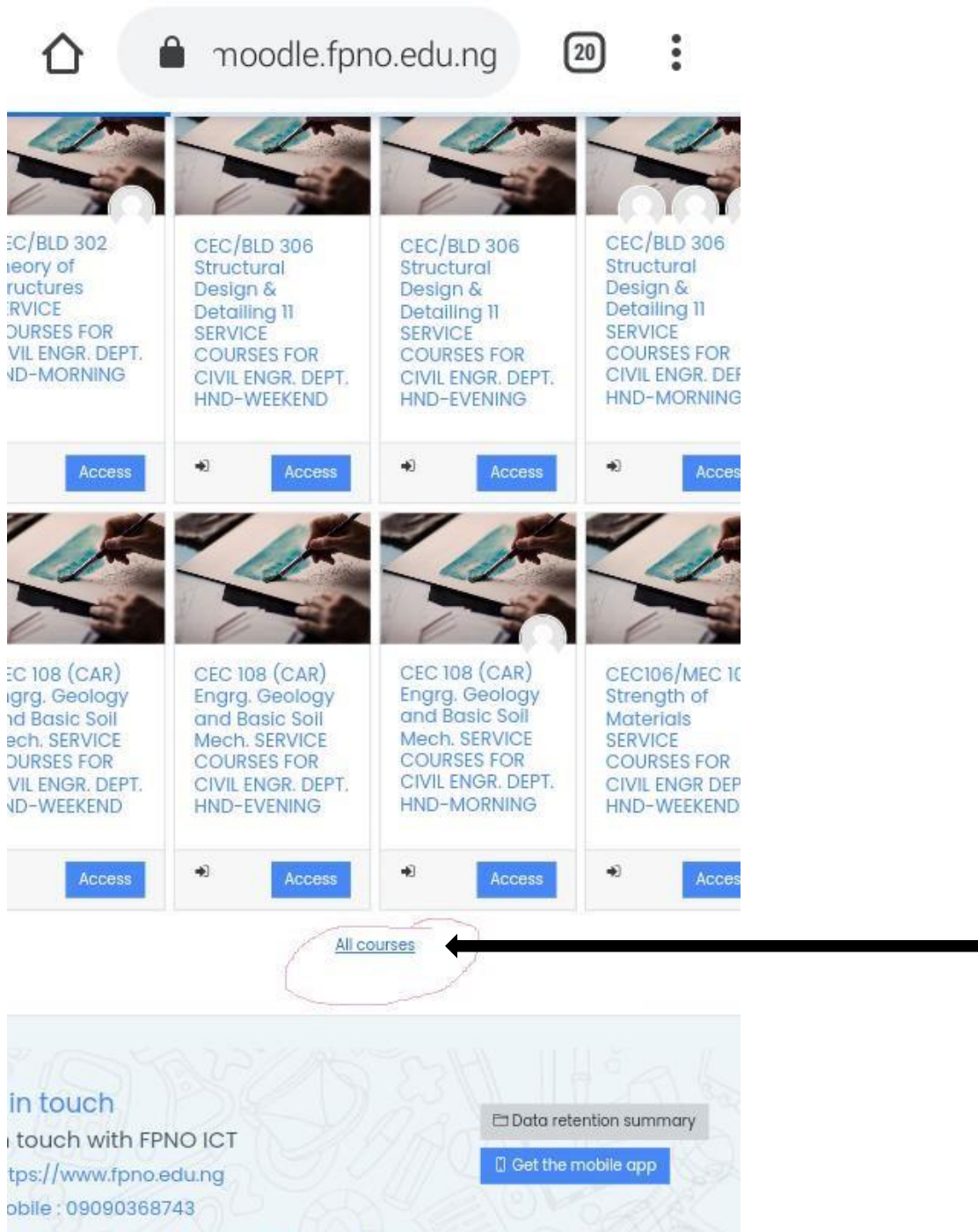
STEP 11: Click on the **Home** icon as shown below



STEP 12: This will take you to where you will see all available courses as shown below.

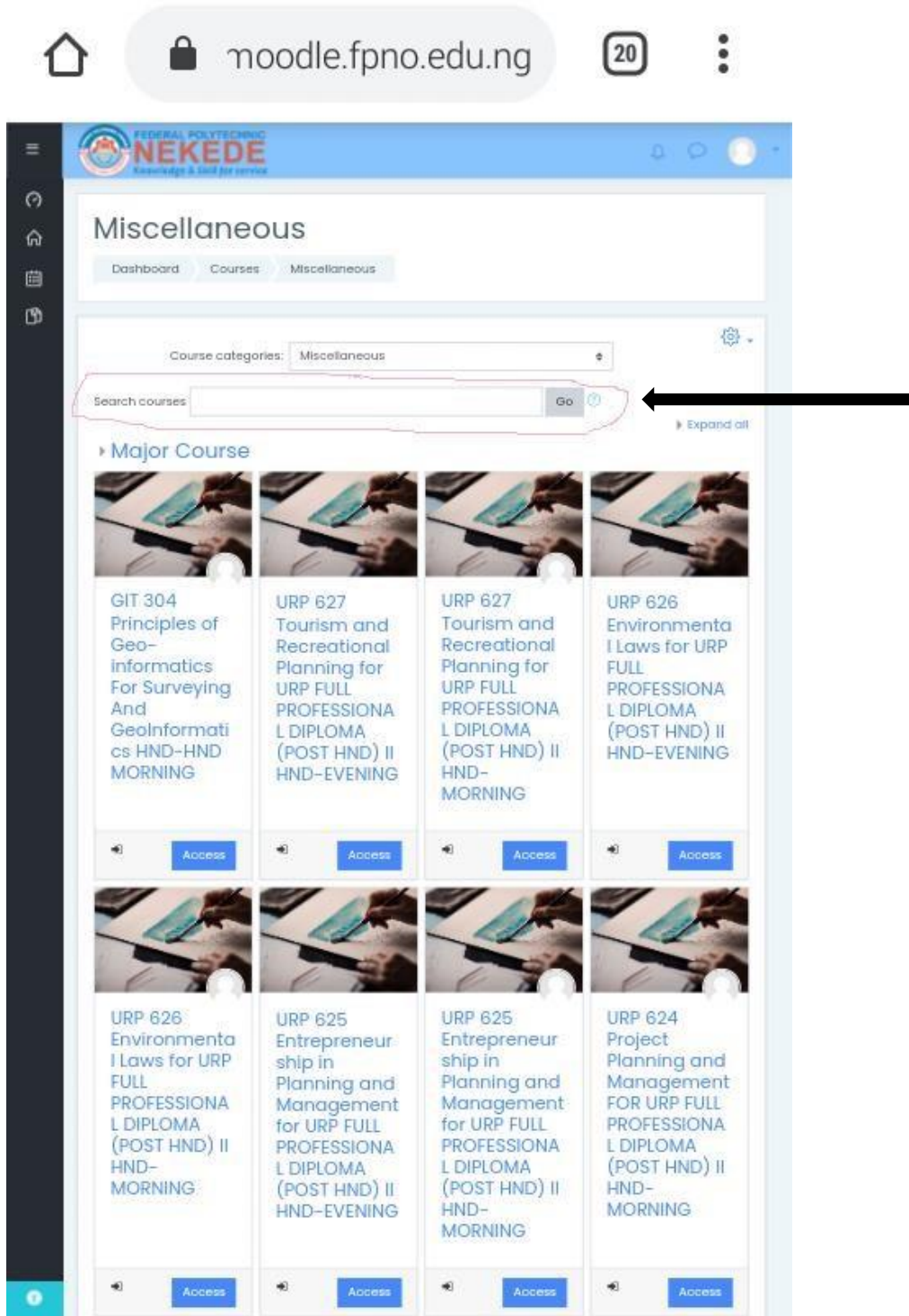

STEP 14: Scroll back up to see “**Search courses**”; in the box beside it, type in the course title you registered in your Portal Dashboard to enroll and join the lectures.

NOTE: Enroll one course at a time.











STEP 15: Type in the course title/course name/course code and click on “Go”

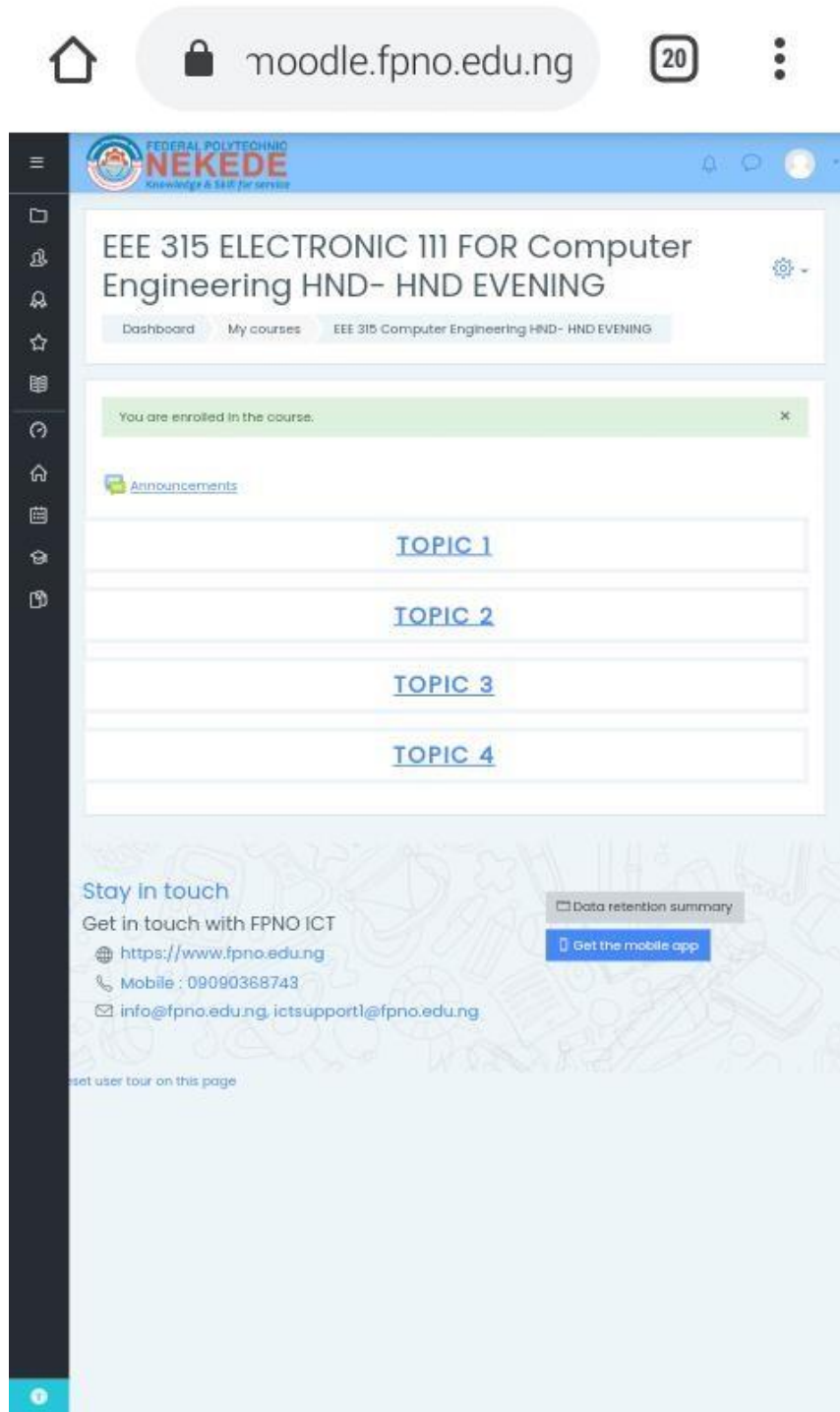

STEP 17: This will take you to a page as seen below, click on **“Enroll me”**.

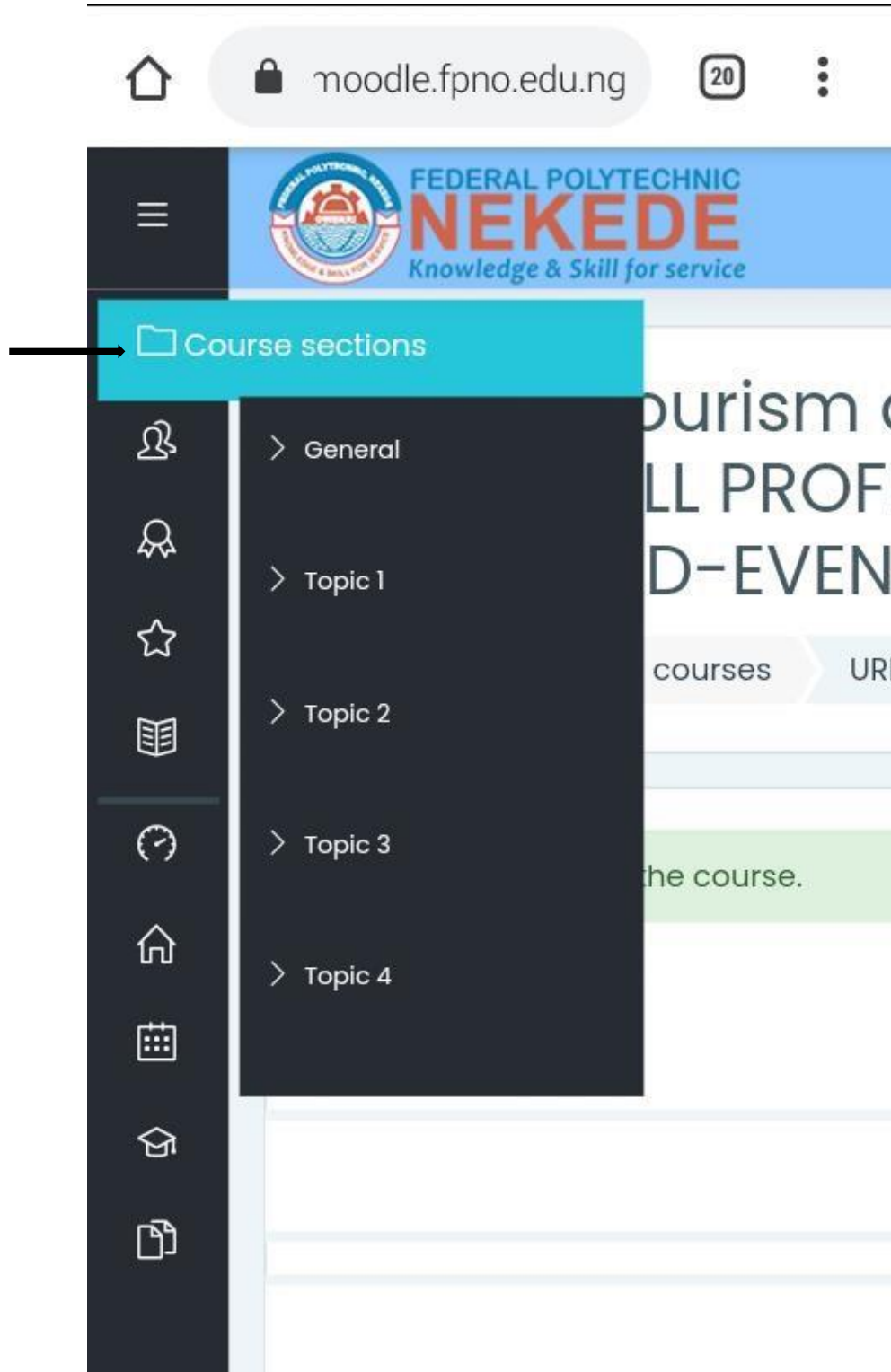

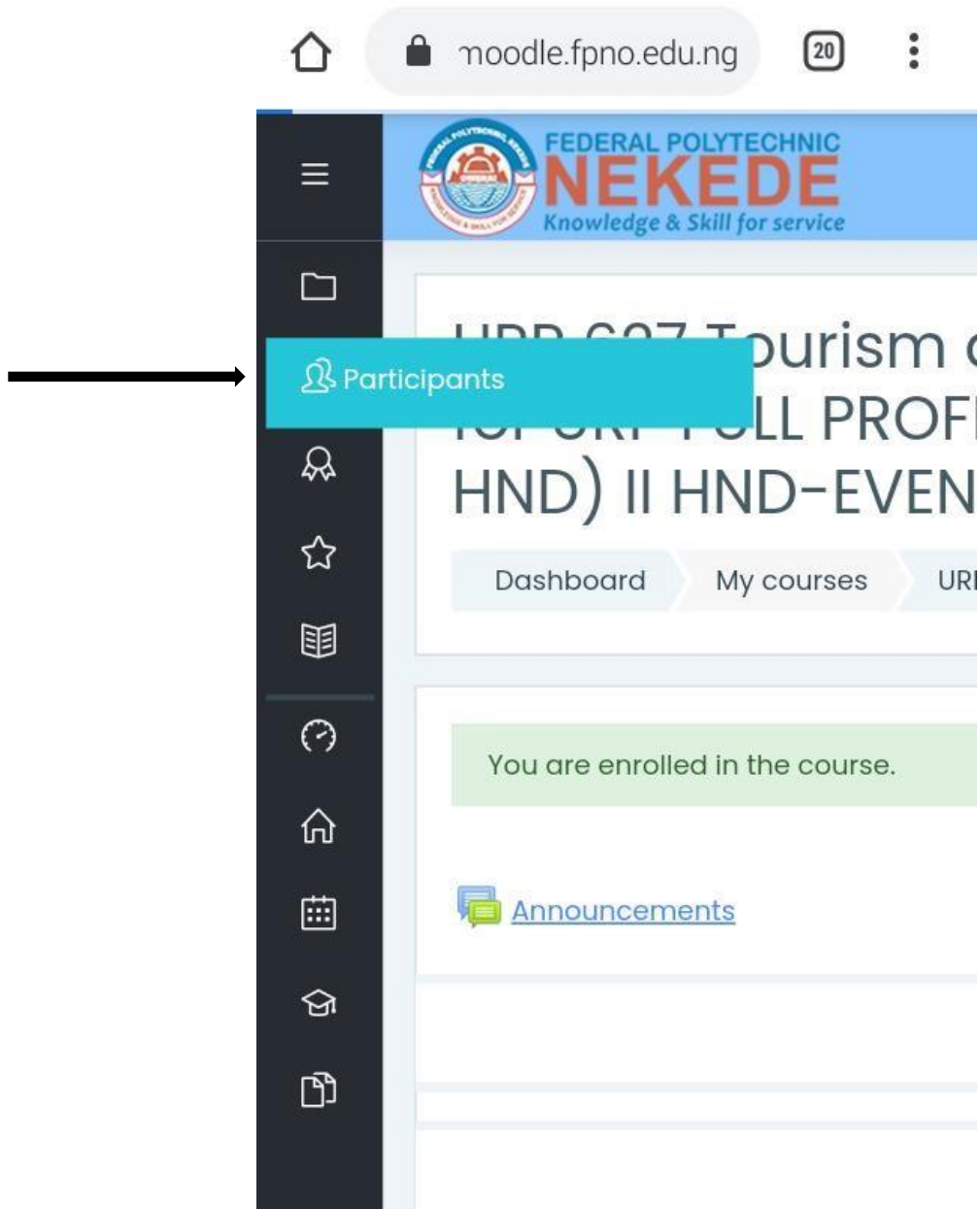
NOTE: Always check the **Announcements** to find out when there will be an Assignment, test/quiz or exams etc.



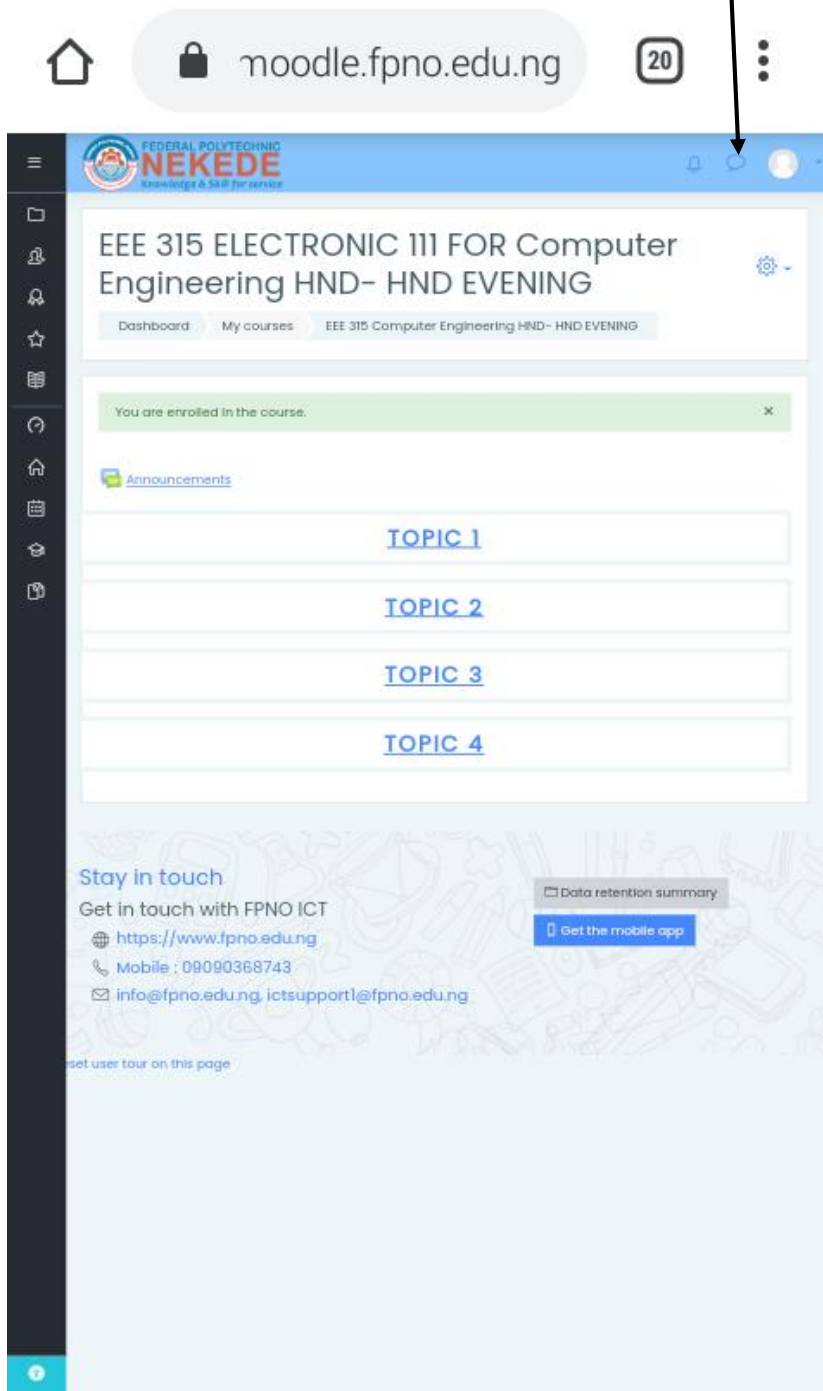
STEP 19: You can also see the topics of that particular course on the first ICON on the menu as shown below.
