ENTRY REQUIREMENTS NATIONAL DIPLOMA (ND)EVENING PROGRAMME

The entry requirements for all National Diploma (ND) Evening Programmes are as follows:

- 1. Five (5) credit passes in relevant subjects including English Language and Mathematics obtained at not more than two sittings in WAEC/NECO or NABTEB (O'level Examinations).
- 2. Candidates are required to obtain JAMB Part-Time Registration Number from JAMB Office or JAMB Accredited (CBT) Centres.

For details on entry requirements peculiar to each of the courses above, candidates should visit the Polytechnic website www.fpno.edu.ng.

Please note that candidates with Nov/Dec. O'level result of year of admission for ND evening programmes are not qualified to apply.

It is important to **NOTE** that any false data entry during the on-line registration will lead to disqualification of the candidate at anytime such is discovered.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

- 1. All candidates MUST first go to the school's website **www.fpno.edu.ng.** and click on "Application form" link" on the home page under student's menu, choose ND to proceed.
- 2. Fill your Bio-data in the form and generate an invoice, print or copy out the invoice number, (you can do this on your mobile phone).
- 3. Proceed to Federal Polytechnic Nekede Microfinance Bank or any bank of your choice and make a payment of (N12,000.00) Twelve Thousand Naira only on Remita platform, using RRR number on the invoice you generated.

You can also choose to make payment using your VERVE, VISA or MASTER CARD. If you choose the card payment option, you will be asked to fill the card details for the payment to be processed immediately.

4. Return to the school's website <u>www.fpno.edu.ng</u>. click on "application form", and complete your application process. Submit your data as requested and print out your acknowledgment slip. If you process your

- 5. payment using your card, you will return to the portal immediately to print your receipt and acknowledgment slip.
- 6. All Application procedures MUST be completed on or before 12 midnight of 28th February, 2024.

Applicants can start and complete this process from any location in the country. It is therefore advisable to minimize trips to Owerri for the purpose of completing the form.
